It is an artistic resource to be used by educators and youth workers to promote active citizenship and Human Rights awareness through a pedagogical

approach.



The tool is composed by an illustrated manual of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, an illustrated Handbook of Invisible Discrimination, and a video animation regarding freedom of expression.



The iPrepare tool is an interactive web surface offering online preparation to volunteers departing soon for a long term international project within European Solidarity Corps as well as its predecessor, European Voluntary Service.

In the framework of the European Youth Week Social Youth Development (K.A.NE) organized activities for students of the city and for students who live out of the city of Kalamata. First of all, K.A.NE made visits to 2 schools which are out of the city. The activities organized on purpose there, so the students who live out of Kalamata will have access to nonformal education.

In more details, the students had the chance to participate in a simulation game for active citizenship which made them think deeply of the meaning of active citizenship.

Additionally, apart from the meetings with the schools, K.A.NE organized a public event where a world café took place. In this one students participated, were divided into groups and they discussed topics such as democracy, active citizenship, identity etc.

EU.MOTION, THE START OF AMC'S ADVENTURE IN THE EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS

TACC SPAIN - MORE THAN 200 PEOPLE ATTENDED THE PREMIERE OF THE DOCUMENTARY "YALAH" IN SABADELL

On Wednesday, February the 27th, Sabadell once again demonstrated its commitment to the Sahrawi people in a key year, in which it is commemorated the 30 years of Twinning between Sabadell and Argub (Western Sahara). On the day the 43rd anniversary of the proclamation of the Arab Democratic Sahrawi Republic (RASD) was celebrated, the city hosted the premiere of the "Yalah" documentary.

The documentary, with the authorship of TACC and produced by the City Council of Sabadell, is one of the actions that have been carried out based on the new twinning project of Sabadell with the Sahrawi people.

Yalah shows five stories of anonymous people living in Sahrawi refugee camps. These stories are linked to the five axes of the current twinning project between the Sahrawi people and the city of Sabadell: gender, awareness, youth, education and health.



Among the audiences, so heterogeneous, it was highlighted the assistance of some of the young people who assisted in the 2018 Saharan solidarity camps, some of the members of Solidaris with the Saharawi People of Sabadell, and even some Saharawi who live in the city. Míriam Ferrándiz and Mario Álvarez were in charge of presenting the event and of contextualizing and introducing the public in the current context suffered by the Sahrawi people.
